Mission

Lutheran High North, a school of the Lutheran Education Association of Houston, offers students and families quality academics and meaningful ministry that prepare students to be leaders in their schools, churches and communities.

We opened our doors in August 1980 with a mission to provide an academically rich experience in a Christ-centered environment. LHN offers a rigorous college-preparatory curriculum to approximately 200 students in grades 9 through 12.

Conveniently located off the 610 North Loop between Highway 290 and Interstate 45, Lutheran High North's campus includes:

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Lutheran High North equips students with the tools and knowledge they need to excel — now and in their future endeavors.

Technology

LHN uses the latest technologically advanced teaching tools to enrich the learning experiences of students.

- Students receive an iPad2 customized with apps that are specific to their courses.
- Each summer, LHN updates its classrooms with state-of-the-art equipment, including digital projectors, smartboards and wireless technology.
- Outside the classroom, learning continues with Edmodo, a web-based platform where students collaborate with classmates and their teachers, including posting questions and receiving additional help with assignments, reading summaries of lessons, taking quizzes, turning in homework and more.
- Students may choose technology-related classes in Business Information Management, Desktop Publishing, Multimedia, Robotics and Webmastering.

Academics

LHN's rigorous college-preparatory curriculum challenges students to perform to their potential.

- In addition to regular course offerings, students may choose honors and advanced placement classes.
- For an additional fee, beginning their junior year qualifying students may enroll in dual-credit/college courses taught by Concordia University professors onsite, earning up to 18 college credit hours.
- All-digital online classes help students round out their class schedules in subjects such as Personal Finance.



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Outdoor Classroom

LHN's "outdoor classroom" helps to inspire a spirit of lifelong learning with organized trips abroad. Students, parents, siblings, faculty and alumni are welcome on these 10-day adventures.

- Travelers have a full-time guide who provides in-depth information about the country's history, geography and culture.
- A faculty member schedules annual trips during spring break or early in the summer break.
- A package price that includes airfare, hotel and breakfast and dinner helps make the excursions affordable, and families have the opportunity to participate in fundraising activities to pay for their trips.
- Prior destinations include Scotland and Ireland; Spain; Italy; Germany; Costa Rica; and Prague, Berlin and the Czech Republic.



National & international travel opportunities

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Lutheran High North encourages students to develop all aspects of their character, including their spirituality and call to ministry. Faculty serves as spiritual instructors and role models, each teaching and exemplifying the life and love of Christ every day.

- Students take theology classes each year and attend weekly chapel services.
- Those who participate in choir and band travel to area churches, schools and senior citizens' homes to perform.
- Students are encouraged to participate in volunteer opportunities. Volunteer projects have included food and toy drives and participation in organized fundraising walks.

Ministry and Leadership

A diversity of programs encourage students to further develop their ministry and leadership skills.

• National Honor Society students participate in service projects and school and community endeavors. Those who demonstrate potential leadership skills and attain a required GPA are selected based on scholarship, leadership, service and character.

- Senior Mentors help freshmen adjust to life at LHN, assisting them throughout the school year.
- Service Days benefit several nonprofit agencies, and the entire student body, faculty and staff, as well as many parents and LHN alumni participate. Together they plan and carry out much-needed work in the community.
- Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools (TAPPS) Competitions offer students the opportunity to showcase their talents and knowledge. LHN students consistently excel in music, drama and art in local, regional and state TAPPS competitions.
